

The CEUI Health and safety training offered is for all state workers who face hazards on the job. A wide range of workers face chemical, biological, radiological and physical sources of danger on the job.

The CEUI-SEIU Local 511 training method

Our training is unique for two reasons. First it is conducted by CEUI members who have completed a 40 hour train the trainer course. The use of peer trainers enhances the program's credibility and effectiveness with workers. The cooperation of management and union in presenting the training also sends a significant message that both parties are working together to increase employees' wellbeing.

The curriculum is based on a small group problem solving format. This method fosters discussion and creates an environment where employee concerns are easily expressed. The active nature of the training keeps participants engaged in the material, increasing the likelihood that information will be retained once the training is over.

Employers and employees alike have praised our training method. One municipal risk manager said:
